

## ACCYL...Basketball, Service, Mission

The ACCYL not only values basketball but places get emphasis on service, mission, and out-reach. The league highly encourages each team to complete at least one service project (teams can do more than one project). The league has a relationship with the three organization listed below. However, a team is allowed to creatively discover their own area of service.

- **Possibilities can include:** Lutheran Malaria Initiative, Feed My Starving Children, Salvation Army St. Paul Citadel Center Bell Ringers, soup kitchen, your church events, homeless shelters, "Souper Bowl" Sunday, Bridging: Serving Families in Transitions
- **Teams receive 3 points** for their 1st project and 2 points for their 2nd and 3rd projects (3 projects maximum)
- Teams are highly encouraged to complete the projects in fall 2010 or during the season. **Deadline to complete:** February 20, 2011.
  - **A project needs to include 90%** of players and coaches on the team.

**W**e welcome you to the Augsburg College Youth Basketball League's 2011 season sponsored by Augsburg College's Campus Ministry and the congregations who participate in the league. This is the league's twentieth season of providing opportunities for congregations of all denominations to allow junior high and senior high boys and girls youth the chance to experience lots of fun through the game of basketball.

**U**ltimately, the Augsburg College Church Youth Basketball League emphasizes: fun, service, sportsmanship, mission, relationships, and growth of one's faith in Jesus Christ, higher than winning basketball games!

### **About the league: On the average each year...**

- 40 teams register for the league.
- 20 congregations sponsor these teams.
- Approximately 400 youth participate together with 80 adult coaches, assistants and officials.
- It is estimated that half or more of every team is made of youth not belonging to the church they are playing for. This means that the league is a significant tool of outreach for the churches that are involved in the league.
- Adults and parents serve as coaches, scorers, timers, officials, gym managers, and record keepers.
- The league features four different program opportunities, including senior high (grades 9-12) boys, senior high girls, as well as middle school (grades 6-8) boys and middle school girls.
- The league takes place on Sunday afternoons between January 9 and March 6, 2011, with game times at 1:30, 2:45 and 4 pm at various church gyms around the metro area. The season ends with a tournament at Augsburg College on March 6, 2011.

### **The League's Mission**

**T**he Mission of the Congregational Youth Basketball League is to provide relaxed yet structured games in a Christian setting, allowing kids an opportunity for fun and exercise while building relationships with teammates, opponents and God. Through these games and practices, Christian values will be promoted throughout the coaching ranks and spiritual growth will be encouraged within each team and individual. Each individual has the opportunity to enjoy the game of basketball, regardless of ability or experience, and in doing so is able to achieve a feeling of success.

\*Early bird registration is \$300. if postmarked on or before November 5, 2010.

\*Late fee of \$50 if you check is not postmarked by December 3rd, if there is space available.

\*\$175 of your registration fee is refundable through December 26, 2010. No refunds after this date.
