Code of Conduct

The Augsburg College Church Youth League is a Christian league and thus promotes good sportsmanship by students, coaches and spectators. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants and officials in a positive manner. Profanity, racial comments or other intimidating actions directed at officials, students, spectators, coaches or league representatives will not be tolerated and are grounds for removal from the site of competition. Also, you are reminded that the consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages or any chemical is prohibited. As a participant involved in the Augsburg College Church Youth League, I agree to abide by and follow the rules and guidelines listed below:

1. I will treat all players, coaches, and officials with dignity and respect in language, attitude and behavior.
2. I will encourage good sportsmanship through my actions, by demonstrating positive support for players, coaches, and especially, all referees.
3. I will treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with the same respect he/she expects to receive.
4. I understand the game is for the athletes and not for the spectators.
5. I will inform the coach of any physical challenges or ailment that may affect my safety or the safety of others.
6. If necessary, I can remind players, coaches, and spectators of the code of conduct guidelines. I can also contact my church or league director if behavior persists.
7. I will respect the property and equipment used at any game or practice sports facility. (i.e. clean up trash, set up and take down of facility, returning basketballs and all other equipment)

I agree that failure to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines may result in disciplinary action by the Augsburg College Church Youth League. This action could include, but is not limited to the following: Verbal warning, Written warning, Parental game suspension, Parental season suspension, Player suspension, Player removal, Coach suspension, or Coach removal.
